8	<b>ILLNESS OR INJURY</b>	<p>A gymnast will only be excused from a trial through illness or injury with a valid doctor's certificate. A profile will be taken into consideration from valid competitions approved by the Technical Committee.</p> <p>A gymnast can be removed from the team on the following basis:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Non-compliance in training</li> <li>2. Violation of the codes of behaviour</li> <li>3. Injuries at a late stage</li> </ol>
9	<b>COACH SELECTION</b> <i>(Head Coach and Assistant Coaches)</i>	<p>Criteria: Senior Coach, minimum qualification Level 4. Coach with the most Senior gymnasts. In the event of a tie the coach of the 1<sup>st</sup> placed gymnast at the trials will be appointed as coach.</p> <p>Assistant Coach, coach for juniors, 2 options</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Merit, minimum qualification Level 3. Coach with the most junior gymnasts.</li> <li>• PDI Coach, earmarked for training as a high Performance coach. Minimum qualification Level 2 on merit.</li> <li>• In all scenarios the profile of coaches will be looked at.</li> </ul>
	<b>JUDGE SELECTION</b> <i>(Merit vs Rotation)</i>	<p>It will probably be an FIG sanctioned event (to be confirmed) only Brevet judges will be allowed to judge. Highest qualified FIG Brevet judges available</p>
11	<b>TRANSFORMATION TARGET</b> <i>(As per SAGF Equity Goals)</i>	Currently no SAGF Transformation percentage to adhere to.
12	<b>TEAM APPROVAL</b>	The selected gymnasts and officials will be forwarded to the High Performance Manager, who will then submit a recommendation for approval to the Board of SAGF. The Technical committee facilitates and motivates the selection.
