All Clubs, Districts and Provinces are reminded that in order to participate at Nationals (Lev 4+) that all gymnasts **MUST** have qualified at the set qualification competitions as prescribed by their provinces e.g. from District to Provincial to National – it also stands to reason that the correct prescribed set routines are used.

The online Gym Games competition entry system will be active from Friday 1st September to Friday 8th September.

All Gym Games entries this includes judges and coaches **MUST** be submitted during this period, on the online entry system.


Competition will be run on 2 Apparatus simultaneously we will need Judges as follows:
