1. Provisional Travel Arrangements – (SAGF To Confirm)

Gymnasts will fly, as a team, to Walvis Bay leaving RSA on the 7th December and will return, as a team, on the 9th December 2017. It is the responsibility of the parents to inform the SAGF if your child will NOT be travelling with the team, failure to do so will render you liable for any cancellation or costs incurred. The Namibian Gymnastics Federation will arrange all transportation in Walvis Bay. Please ensure that you have a passport that is valid for the duration of time that you are away.

Those travelling on a South African Passport do not need a VISA. Should you be travelling with a non-South African passport, you will require a VISA.

As this is an international trip – SA laws regarding the travel of minors are applicable (see attached information and consent form attached). **NB Certified full-unabridged birth certificates for all minors 17&U are required. If you don't have one to hand we suggest that you apply for one ASAP, as this can take anything up to 6 weeks to obtain from home affairs.**

2. Accommodation

Gymnasts will be accommodated in chalets and will be provided with breakfast, lunch packs and supper. The Namibian Gymnastics Federation will provide transport to and from the accommodation to the competition and training venue.

3. Clothing

All gymnasts are required to have the blue Region 5 Federation Tracksuit, leotards, shorts, longs, & t-shirts. Although there is an official backpack, this item is not compulsory. The uniform for this competition has not changed so should you already be in possession of the official attire, you will not need to purchase these items again.

4. Team Acceptance Form, Code of Conduct, Consent and Clothing Order Forms

The Acceptance Form, Code of Conduct, Consent and Clothing Order Forms are to be completed by selected participants by 23rd October 2017 and returned to the SAGF. Please note that once you have indicated that you will compete in the Region 5 competition in Namibia, you will be liable for all associated costs.

5. Special Dietary Needs / Medical Requirements

All dietary and medical requirements must be submitted to the team manager in writing along with the Acceptance Forms.

8. Confirmation of Participation
