the hosts of the Gym Games.



COMPETITION CARDS

Please note that ALL competition cards MUST be handed in on Thursday , 26th September 2019 at 13h00. Please put every competition day's cards together, separate from the cards for the other days Mark clearly which day's cards it is. Boys and girls for each day also separately, boys cards together, girls cards together. No competitor will be allowed to compete if the competition card is missing. Please note that the boy's competition cards should be printed on blue paper and the girls on pink.
